

## ABOUT GUYANA

Guyana is called “the land of many waters” and was settled by the Dutch in the 17<sup>th</sup> century. As a result to increased African slave trade, many Amerindian natives fled to the country’s interior and established villages.

Today, the Amerindian villages are most Roman Catholic and many have Anglican and Pentecostal denominations. The Lord’s church has a presence in some but not all.

The goal of **Living Water 414** in Guyana is to establish faithful congregations in every village and to strengthen existing churches through campaign preaching and teaching as well as training preachers in Guyana Christian University.
